



COVID-19 Rules of Play

UPDATE 06 9th July 2020

The Scottish Government have today announced that one household can now mix with up to five different households so we can advise the following changes will take effect from Friday 10th July.

GROUPS

Four households are permitted within a 4 ball on either course.

TEE TIMES

1562 Course

4 ball groups permitted from 7.30 am Sunday to Friday. Saturday play will remain as 3 ball groups.

Broomfield Course

4 ball groups permitted from 7 am 7 days a week

FACE COVERINGS

Face covering must be worn when entering the professional shop.

HAAR

As we are now in the summer season there is always the threat of coastal Haar!

In the event of extreme or adverse weather. (Rule 5.7, Stopping play, resuming play)

- Dangerous Situation - Immediate Stop 1 prolonged note of the Klaxon
- Non-Dangerous Situation - Hole may be completed before halting 3 notes of the Klaxon (repeated)
- Resume Play 2 notes of the Klaxon

This information is also found in the Local rules on the back of the scorecards and applies to both the 1562 course and the Broomfield.
