SEEDED DIVOT RELIEF

You must play the ball as it lies if you land in a seeded divot during competition play. We ask you all to please lift your ball out of a seeded divot if you are playing a non-competitive game.

BUNKER LIE RELIEF

With immediate effect Montrose Golf Links will revert from allowing players with a club lengths relief in a bunker to moving the ball within 6 inches.

COURSE ETIQUETTE

As everyone knows, the course has been fairly busy recently and this has exacerbated several of the problems we experience during a round of golf. We would therefore ask you to remember the following the next time you play:-

- a. Repair pitchmarks - this includes any you see which may not be your own!
- b. Pick up broken tees.
- c. Replace your divots.
- d. Smooth the sand in the bunker after playing your shot - using your foot or a club.
- e. Keep up with the group playing in front of you.
- f. Play your shot only when it is safe to do so.

Lastly, please take your litter home with you!

BROOMFIELD 9TH HOLE

Please read the notices placed on the 1st and 9th tee positions and observe the instruction which is to the effect that we prefer irons to be used on the 9th tee. If a ball exits the course beyond the boundary on the 9th fairway it is the responsibility of the golfer to report this to the professional shop at the end of the game. Golfers are reminded of the need to shout 'fore' in the event that a ball has been struck out of play or in the direction of fellow golfers or members of the public.
